

## Truth School 2019

Dear Parents, Truth School Students, and Workers,

Thank the Lord that He has given us another opportunity to come together for Truth School. During the two-week period of July 14<sup>th</sup> through July 26<sup>th</sup>, we will be covering **Truth School Lesson Book 5: The Church—The Vision and Building Up of the Church**. The detailed, daily schedule has not yet been finalized, but when the details have been worked out, it will be made available at [www.ypaustin.com/truthschool](http://www.ypaustin.com/truthschool). Students who have completed the 6<sup>th</sup> grade and are entering the 7<sup>th</sup> grade through the 12<sup>th</sup> grade are eligible to participate.

We are again planning to have the Friday night BBQ for friends of the truth-schoolers. Additionally, we would like to invite these friends to the Saturday night love feast and Lord's Day morning meetings! The Saturday night love feast and the two meetings on the Lord's Day are required for all truth-schoolers.

### **Registration:**

**NO registration applications will be accepted after June 30<sup>th</sup>.** To initiate the registration of your child (or yourself as a worker), simply send a text to Paul Bixby (512-784-6625), containing the following 8 lines of information: (1) "Attn. Truth School", (2) name of student or worker, (3) city/locality, (4) indicate "brother" or "sister", (5) "grade" level in school this Fall – indicate 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, or "W" for worker, (6) T-shirt size – indicate S, M, L, XL, or XXL, (7) for attendance, indicate "1<sup>st</sup> week only", "2<sup>nd</sup> week only", or "both weeks", (8) "can give hospitality" or "cannot give hospitality" or "need hospitality." If you can give hospitality, then indicate how many brothers or sisters you can accommodate. Only indicate "need hospitality" if you are coming from outside the greater Austin area (Round Rock and San Marcos are included in the greater Austin area) and need the Truth School to help arrange your child's hospitality. If this is your case, Truth School asks you to provide an additional \$50 per person per week, and Truth School will pass this donation directly on to the host when these arrangements are finalized. Here is an example of your simple text to Paul Bixby:

**Once your text is received by Paul Bixby, your student (or you as a worker) will be considered registered, you will receive an acknowledgment text, and instructions for medical release forms and for paying your donation will be given.** A donation of \$100 per week will be collected for each student. Workers are asked to make a small contribution of \$20 per week to help defray the costs that are incurred. Out-of-town saints, i.e. those coming from outside the greater Austin area (Round Rock and San Marcos are included in the greater Austin area), who are requesting the Truth School to work out their hospitality, should add \$50 per week,

which will be passed on by the Truth School directly to the assigned host. **A special \$20 discount per week** will apply to all Truth School **student applicants** who text their information to Paul Bixby by **June 23<sup>rd</sup>** (a simple text with the 8 pieces of information mentioned above). Initiating your registration early will greatly facilitate our planning and preparation. **NO registrations will be accepted after June 30<sup>th</sup>**. **Dress Code:**

As would be expected, dress must be modest and appropriate. **The truth-schoolers will be required to wear a Truth School T-shirt at all Truth School events.** All the brothers and sisters will be given three T-shirts at the beginning of the Truth School. Sisters must wear pants or capris during all Truth School activities since dresses or skirts would not be appropriate during recreation. As in the past, no shorts are allowed. We require that those attending wear tennis shoes and socks (no flip-flops).

**Supplies:**

Students will need the following: An Old and New Testament Recovery Version with footnotes and a backpack. Concerning things not to bring, the young people will not be allowed to use any electronic devices for entertainment. Please remember to put your name on any of your sports equipment. **Please send money with your child to cover the expense of eating out (\$25 per week, suggested).**

**Arrival:**

All truth-schoolers attending the first week are expected to attend a **Truth School Welcome Dinner on July 14<sup>th</sup>**. We will meet at the Congress meeting hall (2530 S. Congress Ave.) at 6:00pm, immediately following the last message of the summer video training, which takes place from 4:00-6:00pm. Family members of the truth-schoolers are invited to this Welcome Dinner.

**Departure:**

Truth School will end on Friday, July 26<sup>th</sup> at 9:00pm. To avoid any inconvenience for the hospitality, please arrange to pick up your child/children on this day; if this is not possible, please fellowship with your hospitality.

**Prayer:**

Please pray that all our young ones would have their hearts warmed to love the Lord and the church fervently and that their being would be sanctified in the truth. Also, pray that the serving ones would be supplied to minister Christ as life to these dear young people.
